Discussion

The extent to which the AAPC Lines of Effort are implemented through statutes and regulations varies. The AAPC line of effort with the greatest percentage, around 50%, of related State of Alaska Statutes, Bills and Resolutions is "Promote Economic and Resource Development". The largest ratio of "Promote Economic and Resource Development" is "Bills Passed" – with 16 out of 24, or 67%. Why is legislation related to "Promote Economic and Resource Development" most common in the State of Alaska?

In Report #1 of this series, we found that the largest portion of graduate-level research at UA was related to the "Support Healthy Communities" line of effort, followed by the "Strengthen Science and Research". In Report #3, we found that State of Alaska Departments related to natural resources (e.g., Fish and Game) had the greatest "Arctic" relevance. The greater amount of research by UA
